The 10-Minute Morning Trading Plan

A simple pre-market routine for checking market bias, live levels, risk, crypto, gold, futures, and trade planning before you enter.

Your morning should not start with ten browser tabs.

Use this guide to build a calmer routine: know the direction, know the key levels, know when to wait, and only then decide if a trade is worth taking.

Why Traders Need A Morning Routine

Most traders do not need more information. They need a better morning routine. Charts, news, watchlists, earnings, economic calendars, social media, and broker platforms can create noise before the market even opens.

The problem

Too many tabs. Too many opinions. Not enough clarity about what matters today.

The routine

Check the market tone, identify the best setup, define risk, then wait for a clean entry.

The outcome

You start the day prepared instead of reacting to every candle.

The simple rule

Direction from the app. Entry from the chart.

Market Signal Desk helps you form the directional plan. Your chart helps you decide whether the entry location is clean or if the trade is a chase.

The 10-Minute Checklist

1. Market Pulse

Check stocks, crypto, gold, oil, forex, and market sentiment so you know the broad tone.

2. AI Morning Brief

Read the plain-English summary: bias, confidence, risk, and what to avoid.

3. Trade Plan

Review the best setup, entry area, stop area, Target 1, Target 2, and Final Target.

4. Chart Location

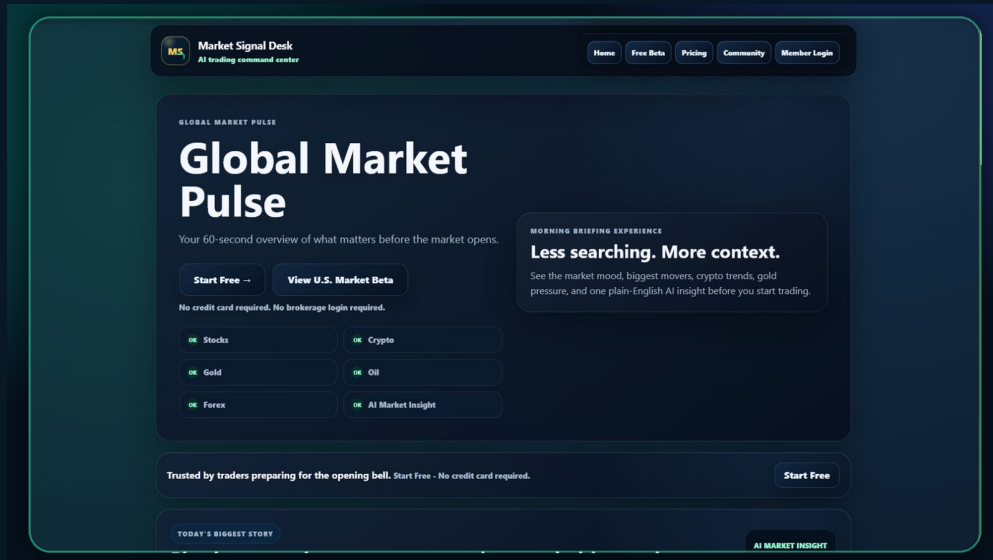
Confirm whether price is near VWAP, EMA 21, prior support, or prior resistance.

5. Risk Decision

If price is stretched, wait. If the setup is clean, define your risk before entering.

Global Market Pulse

Market Pulse is designed for a fast read before the U.S. market opens. It helps you see whether risk assets, crypto, gold, futures, and major indexes are pointing in the same direction or sending mixed signals.

Use this page to quickly answer: Is the market risk-on, risk-off, or neutral? Is gold confirming fear or just moving alone? Is crypto leading risk appetite?

How To Read AI Bias

Long Bias

The app sees conditions favoring long setups. Look for pullbacks and holds, not blind entries at any price.

Short Bias

The app sees conditions favoring short setups. Avoid fighting the signal unless the setup clearly changes.

Neutral / Wait

No strong edge. This is a valid signal. Waiting is often the cleanest trade decision.

Confidence does not remove risk

A high AI confidence score means the conditions are aligned, but it does not mean every entry is safe. If price is far from VWAP or EMA 21, the app may still show the direction while your chart tells you to wait for a better location.

Best practice

Follow the app direction, but let VWAP, EMA 21, support, resistance, and candle behavior decide the entry.

Entry, Stop, Target 1, Target 2, Final Target

Entry area

Where the setup becomes interesting. It is not a command to chase price.

Stop area

Where the idea is wrong or risk becomes too high.

Target 1

First scale-out zone. Reduce risk or take partial profit.

Target 2

Second profit zone. Consider taking more off or moving stop.

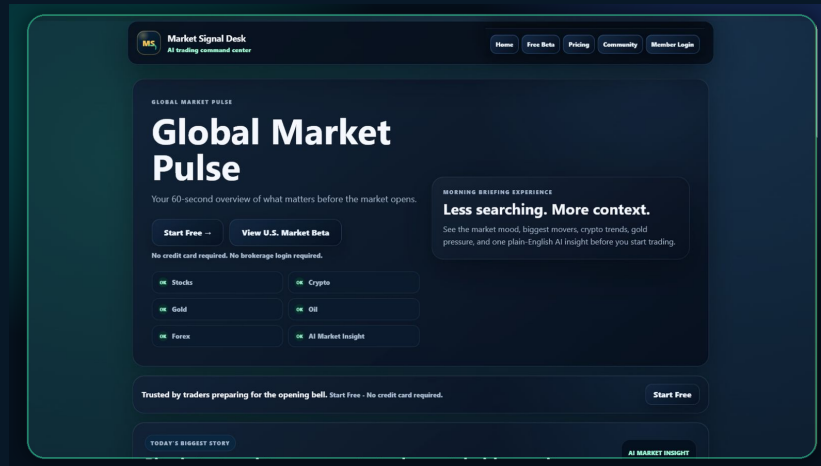
Final Target

Runner objective. Usually a profit-taking area, not an automatic reversal trade.

Important rule

Targets are profit-taking zones. They are not automatic opposite-entry zones. Only trade the other side after real rejection and a confirmed setup change.

VWAP and EMA 21: Avoid Chasing



Example: plan levels and market context

One of the most useful habits is waiting for price to pull back toward value. If the app says Long Bias but price is far above VWAP or EMA 21, the direction may be right while the entry is risky.

- If price is far above VWAP/EMA 21: wait for pullback or consolidation.
- If price pulls back and holds VWAP/EMA 21: look for confirmation with trend.
- If price breaks below VWAP/EMA 21 after a long signal: reassess before entering.

Options and Income Tools

Market Signal Desk is not only for directional stock and futures planning. It also includes tools for traders who want to think about options income, risk, and portfolio context.

Covered Calls

Review potential covered-call income ideas for stocks you already own or are willing to manage.

Cash-Secured Puts

Find put-selling ideas while staying aware of assignment risk and capital needed.

Options Scanner

Screen for opportunities, then use risk notes before acting.

Options reminder

Options involve real risk. Do not sell options only because the premium looks attractive. Always understand position size, assignment risk, expiration, liquidity, and how the trade fits your account.

Daily plain-English market read.

Smart Watchlists

Track important tickers and setups.

AI Trade Planner

Bias, entry area, stop, and targets.

Portfolio

Understand exposure and account context.

Voice Briefing

Listen to the morning plan.

Market Pulse

Stocks, crypto, gold, futures, and sentiment.

Journal

Track reasons, outcomes, and lessons.

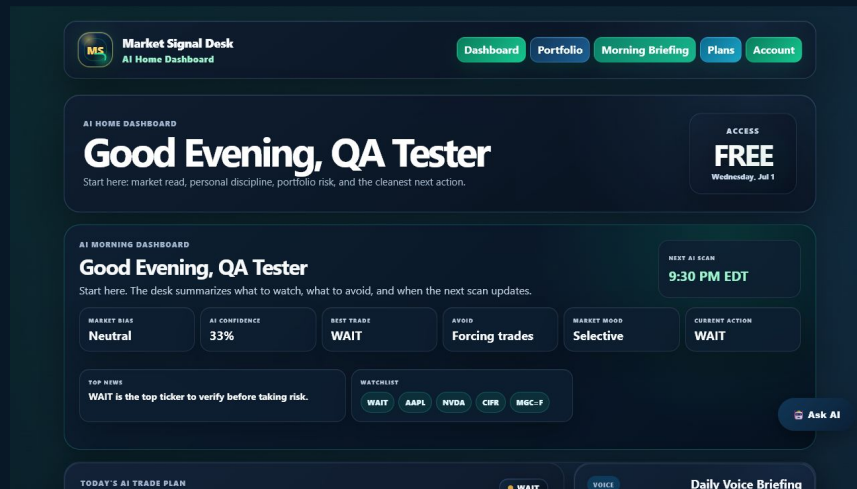
AI Coach

Ask questions and get planning help.

The Trade Discipline Rules

- If the app says Long Bias, only look for long trades or stay out.
- If the app says Short Bias, only look for short trades or stay out.
- If the app says Wait or Neutral, respect it. No trade is a decision.
- Do not chase price far from VWAP or EMA 21.
- Use Target 1 and Target 2 to reduce risk, not to gamble for perfection.
- Never move your stop farther away because you hope price will come back.

How To Use This With Market Signal Desk

Open Market Signal Desk before you trade. Start with Market Pulse, then read the Morning Brief, then review the trade plan. If a setup is not clean, wait. The goal is not to trade more. The goal is to prepare better.
